


Pursuant to ORC 2151.18, of the 93 youth that were referred to Diversion (alternatives to adjudication), 1 was considered unsuccessful and had to be filed on officially through Juvenile Court.

Also pursuant to ORC 2151.18, HB 410 requires data regarding habitual truancy. Specifically, under ORC 2151.27(G), certain data shall include:

- 1. The number of children placed in alternatives to adjudication,
 - 12
- 2. The number who successfully completed alternatives to adjudication,
- 113. The number who failed to complete alternatives to adjudication and were adjudicated unruly.

During the year of 2021, Preble County Juvenile Court had 1 case that fell into this category.
